The meeting will convene in Open Session at 4:00 p.m. with a motion to go into Closed Session in room #337 pursuant to

- Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1) (c) – considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility; to wit: deliberation of new Superintendent contract; and
- Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1)(a) and (f) - Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations; to wit: for the purpose of holding hearings under Wisconsin Statute 120.13(1)(c) and (e)3; and
- Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1)(g) Conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, to wit: review national lawsuit for social media; and
- Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1) (b) – Considering dismissal, demotion, licensing or discipline of any public employee or person licensed by a board or commission or the investigation of charges against such person, and Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1) (c) – Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, to wit: to consider the preliminary notice of consideration of non-renewal for staff; and
- Wisconsin Statute 19.85 (1)(e) Deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session , to wit: memorandum of understanding with the Green Bay Education Association for the Parties' roles and responsibilities with respect to various leaves of absences for District employees who are members of the Association's certified collective bargaining unit.

The Board will reconvene in Open Session at 5:00 p.m. in room #331 pursuant to Section 19.85(2), Wisconsin Statute to consider the balance of the agenda for the purpose of meeting, discussion, and action as deemed necessary on:
