






Historic District Enrollment Trend








Projected District Enrollment Trend









Projected Elementary Capacity – 2020/21

A Brief History of School Design

<u> 1920's – Industrial Model</u>

- Schools designed to reflect modern thinking
- Standardized thinking and teaching
- Efficient students trained for a repetitious industrial world
- Not flexible





A Brief History of School Design


<u>1960's – Experiment in Open Concept</u>

- Movement began in the UK
- Reaction to standardized teaching and learning
- Thought was students learned better outside of the "box"
- Multi-age / multi-instructor organization
- Building design did not synch with teaching and learning

2000's - Student Centered Learning

- Digitally connected world transforms education
- Students learn anytime, anywhere
- Technology allows for greater individualization
- Spaces become multipurpose and more flexible
- Greater variety of learning environments available




